Classroom Work - 3D Printing

This term in Science students will be designing and 3D printing the new 'best toy'. Students have examined the history of toys, this included looking at a 70 year old doll. Students have also begun using Tinkercad, a computer aided design website and will 3D print their new 'best toys'.



Art with Anita - Portray

Students were asked to paint their own image which helps them use their thought process allowing them to mentally recall the size, shape and position of their own facial features. They were then asked to look at a classmate sitting opposite themselves and to draw his or her image. This time they were instructed to use only their eyes to see the features of their peer. This process uses a different way of creating an image similar to what is in their mind but allows the child to develop their observation skills.









Art with Anita - Murrurundi 150 Anniversary of the Steam Train

Blandford students were invited to join in with the community celebrations for the upcoming Murrurundi Railway 150th Anniversary (2 - 4 April) by creating an artwork to be displayed and possibly sold in the MACC Inc stall.

The children were supplied with canvases donated from the Murrurundi Arts & Crafts Council Inc. The children created a little masterpiece of their own. Some of the children painted a steam train which was drawn onto the canvas using carbon paper and then painted in their own style. Others chose to be very experimental, creating some quite abstract designs. Some interesting colours were discovered from a limited palette.

The children had lots of fun experimenting and joining in on a special communal occasion. Your child's artwork can be viewed at the MACC stall on the dates above. If sold the money will be paid to your child at the conclusion of the event and if not, the artwork will be returned to the student.




